As in previous years, we begin by inviting the top youth bowlers in the Province between the ages of 13 and 18, to participate and enhance their bowling skills. Bowlers finishing first in either the A5PBA Youth Challenge Zones, the CTF Youth Zones, or the YBC Four Steps to Stardom Zone Rolloffs, qualify to be invited along with some of the 120 best young bowlers in Alberta. We are now accepting your applications.


The dates for the next Camp are: **August 5th through August 8th, 2010.**

To help make this Camp beneficial and enjoyable for all participants, some of the top coaches in the province will be on hand to provide one-on-one and small group instructions. We will endeavour to keep the ratio of students to coaches at 4 to 1. The Camp will provide more than just on-lane instruction - it will include video analysis, guest speakers, mini competitions, group discussions and presentations, "ask the pros" sessions, and more!

The registration fee for the 2010 Camp is **\$260.00 (GST Incl.)**. Each participant is responsible for their own transportation to and from Mount Royal University in Calgary (the Host site and residence for all participants). The registration fee covers your accommodation, all meals, transportation to and from all Camp functions, instruction, and lineage during the Camp. All participants must stay in the rooms provided at Mount Royal for the duration of the Camp.
